## What the Employee Combined Campaign Makes Possible:

Five years ago, MaineGeneral launched its Remote Patient Monitoring (RPM) program with a \$50,000 grant from the Davis Family Foundation — but it's our incredible employees who have truly powered its success. By raising \$23,683 since being an ECC beneficiary, our employees have played a critical role in helping transform RPM from a pilot of 25 units into a lifesaving program with 3 full-time staff; actively monitoring 225 patients every day.

With tablets and monitoring tools, RPM keeps a close eye on patients' health from afar, reducing costly hospital readmissions and emergency room visits. Since 2020, our program has supported more than 1,700 patients—and the results speak volumes: zero readmissions for patients on RPM with Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease.
